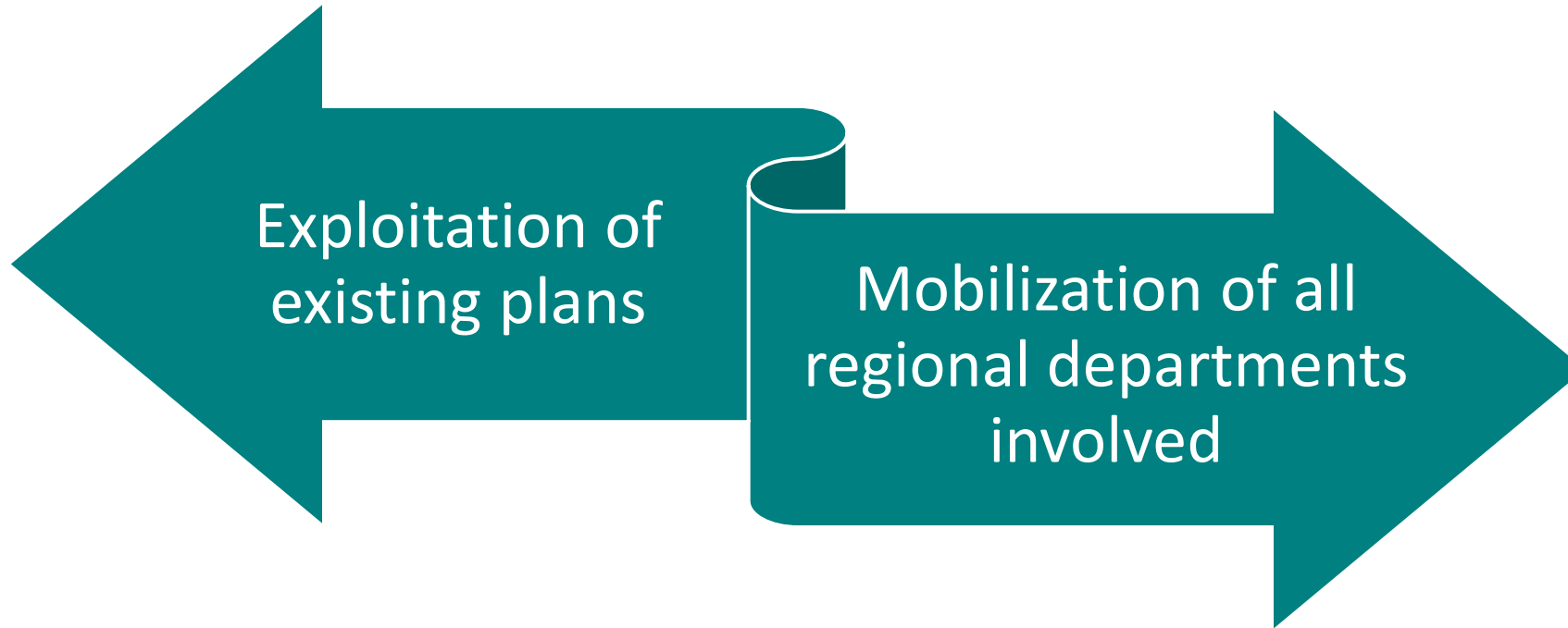

Before starting



Basic steps

- 1 Select the sectors to be examined
- 2 Define activities and respective energy sources in each sector
- 3 Search and collect data
- 4 Choose wisely the baseline year
- 5 Select appropriate methodologies
- 6 Proceed with the development of inventory
- 7 Calculate average and per capita factors and statistics



Tips

1. Consider the pros and cons of methodologies to be used
2. Use recent literature and local literature as possible
3. Pay attention to measurement units and conversions
4. Ensure that data collection process, data sources and methodology are well documented.
5. The methodology and data sources should be consistent through the years.
6. Be as clear as possible in your files to make it easy for the next one to process them.
